

(You must have a Permit number on file with us 2 days before your installation date or we may need to reschedule for a later date that we have available)

1. Ground Zero Shelters will call Okie Dig 811 to mark the area for underground utilities at least 3 days prior to install date. Please provide us detailed driving directions from the nearest main intersection to your home. (Ex. From Grand and 5th Street go South 2 miles to Maple Street and turn East and go 1/2 mile to the house on then North side of the road.)
2. Okie does not mark personal lines from the meter to the home. Please make sure there are no access issues to mark lines.(remove dogs, unlock gates, etc)

3. You must check with your city offices for their guidelines on placement restrictions when you get your permit. Shelter placement requirements for Ground Zero are 5 feet from the property line, at least 5 feet from your home foundation, 3 feet from any utility lines and 15' from any utility easements. Check measurements for the semi access, if it is a straight shot to the shelter location the semi needs a bare minimum of 10 feet wide and 14 feet high clearance into the shelter location from trees, gates, fences, eaves, etc. If the semi has to turn in any way; it needs at least 14 feet clearance height and 14 feet width.

4. You will be required to provide additional monitoring if there is no pavement. If it has been raining, and the driving surface is soft or muddy, the day before or the day of installation, call by 5 am the day of installation to reschedule. If you do not reschedule by that time, and the crew is unable to drive on the surface, you will be charged a \$350 trip charge. You can call our office at 877-880-1351.
